# COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT:

## Empowering Communities for a Brighter Future

The project began with a community meeting, followed by a survey in December 2024, supported by local leaders and residents. The survey gathered data from 310 families, providing key insights to guide development. Through targeted interventions, Oruma aims to empower the community, helping it thrive and become self-sustaining.

## DIALYSIS UNIT

Oruma, in collaboration with Thanal, has been operating a Dialysis Unit at Begam Shafia Nazir Trust Hospital since 2024. This initiative eases the financial burden of dialysis for under-privileged patients, providing essential care at no cost. Through this partnership, Oruma and Thanal remain committed to improving community health by ensuring access to essential healthcare services.

### Nurturing Young Minds

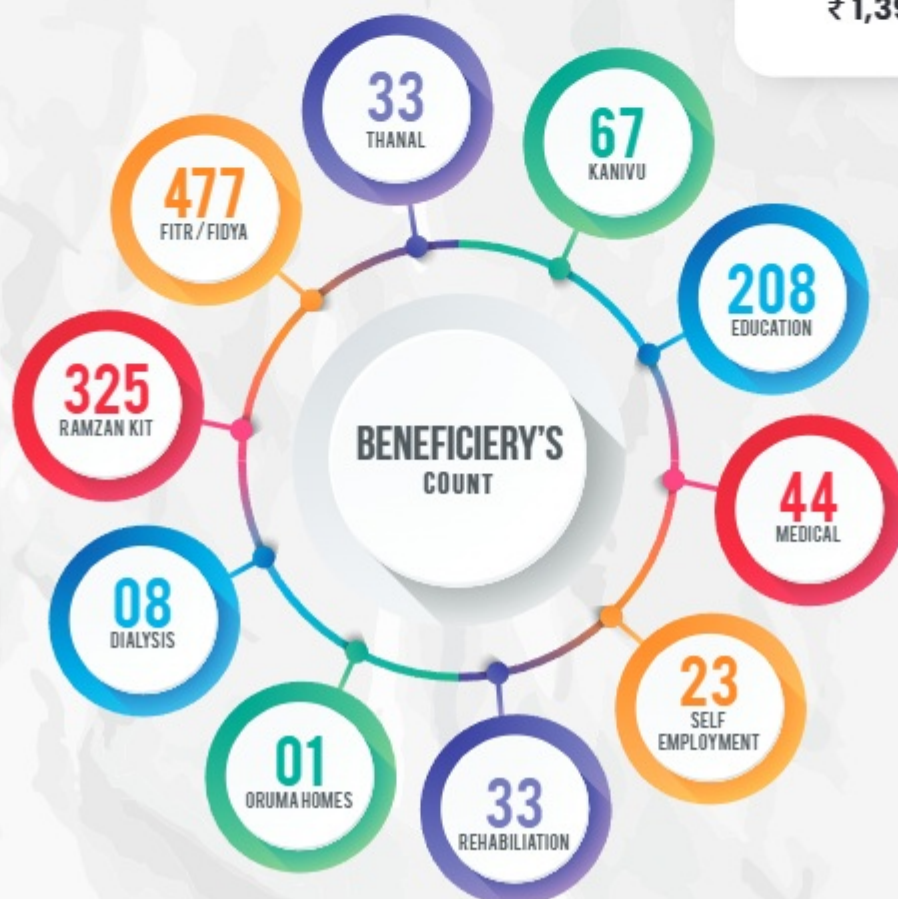
